- Towels – new or gently used; hand towels and wash cloths
- Dog toys – Kongs rubber type
- Cat toys – which can be washed and disinfected (hard plastic type)
- Collars and Leashes – for dogs and cats of all sizes; these are donated to new pet adopters and to the homeless citizens with pets
- Cohon toilet lid rugs – used for cat beds in their cages
- Monetary contributions are always welcome
