Slain Yolo County Sheriff's Deputy Jose 'Tony' Diaz will be driven by motorcade from McNary's Funeral Chapel this Friday, beginning at ten in the morning, to the University of California, Davis, ARC Pavilion. McNary's Funeral Chapel is located at College and Lincoln Streets in Woodland.

The route taken will begin with travel north on College Street to Main Street; east on Main Street to State Road 113; south on State Road 113 to Hutchinson Drive exit in Davis; east on Hutchinson Drive, into the University of California at Davis (UCD) campus to Dairy Road; north on Dairy Road to the Pavilion.

The Memorial Service will begin at eleven in the morning. The general public is invited to attend. Anyone wishing to be there for the service should arrive prior to eleven o'clock. Parking is available for the general public in UCD campus lots 30 and 35.

The media is welcome to attend the Memorial Service. The media will be accommodated in the upper level, southwest corner of the Pavilion, in Section 205. Space has been made available for video photography and still camera usage in this section. Satellite trucks should enter the driveway and park near the Southwest corner of the building located on La Rue Road in Davis. This can be accessed by State Road 113; use the Russell Boulevard exit, turn east on Russell Boulevard; then drive south on La Rue Road. The Pavilion will be on your left.

Any satellite cables needing to be hooked up in the Pavilion must be completed Friday prior to eight in the morning. The Pavilion will be closed off to all public and media from eight to nine-thirty in the morning. All other media vehicles will have parking available in campus lots 30 and 35.

Anyone attending the Memorial Service should expect delays in the areas before and after the service.
