On Monday November 11, 2013 at approximately 7:20 am, a Yolo County Deputy located an unoccupied vehicle parked in the parking lot of the Cache Creek Casino located at Highway 16 in Brooks. In plain view the deputy saw 3 loaded syringes in the vehicle. The deputy waited for the occupant(s) to return to the vehicle. A short time later the deputy made contact with two subjects who returned to the vehicle. A physical search of the vehicle produced 13.5 grams of Heroin, 9.72 grams of Methamphetamine, and 131 units of liquid Methamphetamine.

Michael Brandon Mayberry, 33, of Esparto, and Virgina Monique Perez, 45, of Vacaville were arrested and charged with possession of a controlled substance for purchase, the transporting to sell contraband, possession of a controlled narcotic, possession of a controlled substance, and possession of controlled substance paraphernalia. Mayberry is also being charged with a felony committed while on bail, and possession of counterfeit money. Perez is also being charged with presenting false identification to a Peace Officer, and had two outstanding warrants out of Solano County for possession of drug paraphernalia, and a misdemeanor DUI charge.

Both subjects were transported and booked into Yolo County Jail. Mayberry's bail was set at 370,000. Perez's bail was set at 247,000. Mayberry and Perez are scheduled to be arraigned at the Yolo County Superior Court Thursday, November 14, 2013.
