Subject: Yolo County Deputies Arrest Pair for Stolen Vehicle and Possession of Narcotics

On November 10, 2013 at approximately 10:00 am, Yolo County deputies, while patrolling the Dunnigan area, observed a black 2012 Porsche Carrera traveling eastbound on County Road 4 at County Road 88A, that displayed no front license plate. Deputies followed the vehicle to a residence, where at that point two subjects fled the vehicle on foot. The subjects were quickly apprehended without incident. A registration check of the vehicle revealed it to be stolen, and had been reported to the San Rafael Police Department. A search of the vehicle revealed hypodermic syringes containing liquid Heroin.

Jack Paul Spicer III, 48, of Dunnigan, and Tony Alan Alston, 49, of Richmond were arrested and charged with receiving known stolen property, taking vehicle without permission, and possession of narcotics. Alston also has an outstanding warrant out of Contra Costa County for a parole violation.

Both subjects were booked into Yolo County Jail. Spicer's bail was set at \$1,125,000. Alston's bail was set at \$135,000. Spicer and Alston are scheduled to be arraigned at the Yolo County Superior Court Thursday, November 14, 2013.
