Yolo County Sheriff's Office, Animal Service Section would like to inform the community of our business hours of operation for the upcoming holidays. The shelter will be open on Christmas and New Year's Eve from 9-1pm, and closed Christmas and New Years day. Holiday adoption services will be available on Monday 12/23 from 1-5pm, and Tuesday 12/24 from 9-1pm.

Animal Service Officers will be working normal hours 8-5pm Monday through Saturday (City of Woodland Monday through Friday) with the exception of the County holidays December 25th and January 1st. On Sundays and December 25th and January 1st an on-call officer will be available for emergency call outs for injured, sick or aggressive/biting animals; call 911 to reach a dispatcher.

As a reminder if you need services of the Animal Services Business office i.e., dog licenses or pet adoptions, please plan in advance of the office closure. Any mail received in our office on the first business day after the closures will be considered timely. We appreciate your understanding and apologize for any inconveniences this may cause.
