The Yolo County Sheriff's Office, Animal Services Section wants to recognize Kitten Season is upon us! Your animal shelter is filling with adorable, adoptable cats, kittens and puppies which need your help. One of the ways you can make a difference is by providing a loving home!

Saving lives is what Kitty & Puppy Palooza is all about! Special pricing is effective immediately:

- 1 Kitten: \$15
- 2 Kittens: \$25
- 1 Cat (6+ months of age): \$5
- 1 Puppy: \$50
- 1 Dog (6+ months of age): \$25

Adoption-ready cats and kittens are spayed or neutered, FVRCP vaccinated and microchipped. FELV/FIV testing and Rabies vaccination depends on the age of the feline you choose. The Animal Shelter will even provide you with a "to-go" box if your personal pet carrier is forgotten at home.

Adoption-ready dogs and puppies are spayed or neutered, vaccinated, heart-worm tested and microchipped. Rabies vaccination depends on the age of the dog.

Adoptions end 30 minutes before closing time. Please allow plenty of time to meet your new friend and complete the adoption process. The shelter does remain open for the last 30 minutes of each day for visitors and other business. We accept cash, check, money order and all major credit cards.

Our pets are available on a first-come, first-serve basis. Our goal is to find homes for the animals, so unfortunately we're not able to take requests to hold or reserve a pet.

If you'd still like to help but are not able to adopt a new companion, the Animal Shelter appreciates donations of liquid laundry detergent and Frontline or Advantage. Our dogs love an opportunity to chew on NYLABONE or KONG, while they are awaiting new homes. Cats and kittens love playing with fuzzy mice toys, balls with bells, and ping pong balls! Gently used or new towels and wash cloths are a great help.

As a voice for the animals, we thank our community for their on-going support in helping us save lives. Another way to help is to spay and neuter your pets, make sure they wear a collar and tag, and are microchipped; pets need a way to communicate they have a loving guardian and share where their home is should they wander!

The Yolo County Animal Shelter is located at 2640 E. Gibson Road in Woodland, California. We are open to the public for adoptions and other business 1p-5p Monday, 10a-6p Tuesday-Friday and 10a-4p Saturday. We close for lunch between 1p-2p Tuesday-Friday. The shelter is closed to the public on Sunday.
