FEES: \$30.00 per animal, unaltered or \$15.00 per animal for spayed or neutered. All dogs four months of age or older are required by County Ordinance 6-1.406 to be licensed. Cats may be licensed voluntarily. To qualify for the altered fee, written proof of spay (OVH) or neuter from a veterinarian **must** be submitted at time of payment. You may purchase multi-year licenses based on the expiration of your pet's Rabies Vaccine; vaccine expiration must fall within 30 days of additional years date purchased.

A copy of the current Rabies Vaccination Certificate for each animal must be submitted with the application and payment.
