**Subject: Clarksburg Teacher Arrested for Stealing Prescriptions**

Sheriff's deputies arrested 40 year old Sheri Laverne Haselhuhn, a teacher at Delta Charter School in Clarksburg, Wednesday night after an investigation revealed that she was stealing a student's prescription medication.

At the request of the principal, deputies responded to the school on Tuesday after the school learned that a student's prescription medication had come up short. The school also advised that the pills were kept in a locked cabinet in a room at the school, and the room was under video surveillance. The school advised they would review the video footage and advise deputies if they locate anything suspicious.

On Wednesday afternoon deputies were notified by the school that they had located suspicious activity in the footage they reviewed. A deputy responded and reviewed the footage, dated April 28, 2014. It showed Haselhuhn removing the medication and ingesting it.

At approximately 9:00 PM Wednesday night, deputies contacted Haselhuhn at her West Sacramento home as she pulled into her driveway. Haselhuhn was taken into custody for burglary and possession of a controlled substance and transported to the Yolo County Monroe Detention Center in Woodland. Haselhuhn's bail was set at \$20,000 and she bailed out yesterday afternoon. Her arraignment date is scheduled for June 9, 2014 at 1:30 in Yolo County Superior Court Department 9.
