The Yolo County Sheriff's Office has submitted an OHV Law Enforcement grant, an OHV Safety grant, and an OHV Restoration grant to the California State Parks OHV Division. The Sheriff's Office has received Off Highway Vehicle grant funding since 2009. These funds have allowed for the purchase of equipment, public OHV education and training, and enforcement of OHV laws and County Ordinances associated to OHV use within Yolo County. The funds have also assisted in financially supporting a OHV Enforcement Team and OHV Search and Rescue Team.

As part of the grant process, the preliminary grant applications are now open for public review and comment. We encourage our citizens to access the State Parks OHV website (<u>www.ohv.parks.ca.gov</u>) to review our grant application and make comments. Your comments must be received no later than 5pm (PST) on Monday, May 3, 2021.
